Non-population Census Schedules

Experienced genealogists are well aware of the U.S. federal censuses, 1790-1920, because they are primary genealogical sources. Genealogists use the population schedules, since these schedules list names of residents of the United States for each census year. Yet, for every census year since 1800, other census schedules were produced, such as the special census lists of Union Veterans and Widows prepared in 1890, or the slave schedules compiled for 1850 and 1860. The status of the surviving 1890 Union Veterans' schedules were identified earlier and are not included in this report. This review identifies all known surviving copies of the following non-population census schedules.

1. **Agricultural Schedules** for 1850, 1860, 1870, and 1880
2. **Defective, Dependent, Delinquent Classes** for 1880
3. **Industry and Manufacturing Schedules** for 1800 thru 1880 censuses
4. **Mortality Schedules** for 1850, 1860, 1870, and 1880
5. **Slave Schedules** for 1850 and 1860
6. **Social Statistics Schedules** for 1850, 1860, and 1870
7. **1885 Non-population Schedules** (for those states with an 1885 federal census)

All of the special census schedules are called “non-population schedules” and are not as well known to researchers. It is not surprising that many genealogists know little about these special census schedules because the non-population schedules are not as complete or as readily available as the population schedules. Like the population schedules, the non-population schedules have lists of names. Any document that lists names of people has great value to genealogists and may confirm the home of a person living in the United States back in time.

Unlike most of the population schedules, the non-population schedules are not all in one place. The National Archives long ago decided to return the originals of most of the non-population schedules to any state agency that wanted them. The original manuscripts for most of the non-population schedules were distributed to various state libraries, state historical societies, state archives, or university libraries. Sometimes, the original manuscripts were transferred to some unlikely locations. Original non-population schedules relating to a particular state may be found today in a completely different state. One example is the original 1850-1880 Agricultural Schedules for Georgia which are not in Georgia, but at the Duke University Library in Durham, North Carolina. As it turns out, Duke University has microfilmed

all of Georgia's agricultural schedules. Knowing this, a genealogist may borrow rolls of film from the Duke University Library through the national interlibrary loan system and then use the film at his or her local library. An address for the Duke University Library is at the end of this report, along with the telephone number for their interlibrary loan librarian.

Some non-population schedules were microfilmed by the National Archives; and the film can be obtained on loan by Heritage Quest members. Heritage Quest has virtually every National Archives microfilm series of interest to genealogists, including most, if not all, of the non-population schedules filmed by the National Archives. Several statewide non-population schedules were microfilmed by the repository that holds the originals outside the National Archives. An identification of forty-four different repositories holding original manuscripts or microfilm copies is shown later, along with a full address and telephone number. We will identify all of the non-population schedules that exist for every state, 1800-1880; identify where the original manuscripts are physically located today; and identify where any microfilm versions of the schedules may exist today. In addition, several statewide sched-

ules have never been microfilmed. These can be seen in the Location Table that follows on page 102.

Below, a description of the non-population schedules is given. Following that, a complete list of the schedules taken from various reports (compiled over the last few years) is given. The main source of this information came from a 1995 report of non-population schedules compiled by Claire Prechtel-Kluskens, a staff archivist/genealogy specialist at the National Archives in Washington, D.C. An earlier report produced by the National Archives in 1972 listed population and non-population Schedules, although the 1972 report was mostly superseded by the 1995 report. A check of Heritage Quest's microform catalog confirmed that the existence of most NARA films are in the hands of Heritage Quest and available for loan to its members. Heritage Quest is also acquiring non-population schedules from other repositories. So, if a person needs a particular schedule, check with Heritage Quest first to see if they have it. Other microfilm prepared by an institution other than the National Archives is also shown in this report, giving the name of the repository.

Description of Non-population Census Schedules

The non-population schedules were taken separately from the population schedules. They were all organized in the same manner as the population schedules, that is, by state, county, and subdistrict of a county.

Agricultural Schedules

For the 1850, 1860, 1870, and 1880 censuses, a separate schedule was prepared listing the production for all farms in America. These

schedules show the name of the farm owner, agent, or manager, along with details about his livestock and produce. The types of questions on the 1850 agricultural schedules form are shown below. Each of the other census years had a similar layout:

- Name of owner, agent, or manager of a farm
- Number of improved acres
- Number of unimproved acres
- Cash value of a farm

- Value of farming implements and machinery
- Number of horses, milk cows, working oxen, other cattle, sheep, and swine
- Value of livestock
- Bushels produced during the census year ending June 1, of wheat, rye, Indian corn, oats, rice, tobacco, clover seed, other grass seed, hops, flax seed, and hemp
- Pounds produced during the census year ending June 1, of butter, cheese, flax, cane sugar, maple sugar, beeswax, and honey
- Value of orchard products, in dollars
- Wine produced, in gallons
- Hay produced, in tons
- Gallons of molasses
- Value of homemade manufactures
- Value of slaughtered animals
- Whether an inmate of an institution or a day patient
- Form of disease
- Duration of current attack
- Number of attacks
- Age at first attack
- Whether person must be kept in a cell
- Whether person must be restrained
- Whether person is an inmate in a hospital or asylum
- Total length of time in institution
- Date of discharge
- Whether the person is epileptic
- Whether the person is suicidal
- Whether the person is homicidal

Defective, Dependent, and Delinquent Classes (1880 census only)

A total of seven supplementary schedules under the title *Defective, Dependent, and Delinquent Classes* were prepared for the 1880 census as they applied to each county's census enumeration. These were: Insane Inhabitants, Idiots, Deaf-mutes, Blind, Homeless Children, Inhabitants in Prison, and Pauper and Indigent Inhabitants.

1. Insane Inhabitants. This supplemental schedule lists the following information:

2. Idiots. (In 1880, an *idiot* was the common term for someone who was mentally deficient.) The supplemental schedule listed the following information for each person:

3. Deaf-mutes. This schedule listed the following information:

- Age at which deafness occurred
- Whether person is semi-mute

4. Blind Inhabitants. This schedule listed the following information:

7. Pauper and Indigent Inhabitants in Institutions, Poor-houses or Asylums, or Boarded at Public Expense in Private Houses. This schedule listed the following information:

Industry and Manufacturing Schedules

The 1850, 1860, and 1870 Products of Industry census schedules each had special lists prepared showing manufactured products and other statistics about businesses in general. Any business producing articles valued at \$500 or more per year is listed. In doing so, the name of the business owner, agent, or manager was listed as well as the following information:

- Name of business
- Capital invested in the business
- Raw materials used
- Kind of motive power used
- Average number of hands employed
- Average monthly cost for male wages
- Average monthly cost for female wages
- Annual product: quantities, kind, values

The 1880 Manufactures Schedules added special lists by the category of the business, including the following:

- Boot and shoe factories; and leather and tanning /curing works
- Flouring and grist mills; and cheese or butter processing plants
- Salt works
- Lumber mills, sawmills; and brickyards and tile works
- Coal mines
- Agricultural implement works
- Quarries

Mortality Schedules

These special lists were prepared for the 1850, 1860, 1870, and 1880 censuses. The mortality schedules were taken separately from the

population schedules and list the names of any person who died within one year before the census day. For example, in the 1850 census, which had a census day of 1 June 1850, the mortality schedule for that year lists the name of any person who died between 1 June 1849 and 31 May 1850. The information listed on the 1850 and 1860 Mortality Schedules was as follows:

The 1870 Mortality Schedule included the following information:

The 1880 Mortality Schedule included the following information:

- Age
- Sex
- Color
- Whether single, married, widowed, or divorced
- Birthplace of deceased
- Birthplace of deceased's father
- Birthplace of deceased's mother
- Occupation
- Month of death
- Disease or cause of death
- Months in county
- Place disease contracted
- Name of attending physician
- Whether a fugitive
- Whether manumitted (granted freedom)
- Whether deaf, dumb, insane, or idiotic

Most of the countywide slave schedules list the names of slave owners only; however, some enumerators chose to list the first names of individual slaves on their lists. A researcher must view each countywide slave schedule to see if the names of slaves are shown or not.

Social Statistics Schedules

For the 1850, 1860, and 1870 censuses, a special set of forms was used to gather statistics concerning a particular geographic area within a county. The divisions are described on each schedule page, such as "North Half Fulton County," and the divisions in rural areas do not follow any strict rules. Most divisions are easily identified as townships, towns, cities, or parts of a county. As an example of the type of statistics gathered, the listings for the 1850 Social Statistic Schedules are shown below:

- Total value of real estate for the division
- Total value of personal property for the division
- Names and numbers of colleges, academies, and schools in the division; the number of pupils and number of teachers; and facts about endowments, taxation, etc.
- Names and number of libraries in the division, with description, and number of books
- Names and number of newspapers in the division, with description, publication dates, and circulation
- Poor Houses (pauperism) with a count of the number of native and foreign paupers, and the cost to support them

Slave Schedules

Slave schedules were extracted only for the 1850 and 1860 censuses. In all cases, the schedules list the name of a slave owner and numbers of slaves held by that slave owner. Virtually all of the original manuscripts for all applicable states were retained by the National Archives and all surviving schedules were microfilmed by the National Archives. Heritage Quest currently lists all extant slave schedules in its microform catalog as available for sale to the general public and loan to its members. The information listed on the 1850 and 1860 Slave Schedules was as follows:

- City, town, or subdistrict of slave owner
- Name of slave owner
- Number of slaves, listed by age, sex, and color

- Number of criminals in the division, native and foreign
- Average monthly wage for a farmhand in the division
- Average monthly wage for a day laborer in the division
- Average monthly wage for a carpenter in the division
- Average weekly wage for a male domestic
- Average weekly wage for a female domestic
- Average price of board to a laboring man for a week

1885 Non-population Census Schedules

In 1885, Congress allowed any state or territory to take a census with Federal assistance. Only five states or territories opted to take advantage of this provision. The states and territories that took an 1885 census were Colorado, Dakota Territory, Florida, Nebraska, and New Mexico Territory. The format of the 1885 census was nearly the same as the 1880 and added the same types of non-population schedules as well. The table below lists which of the non-population schedules exist. In addition, the current location of the schedules for each of the five states/territories that had an 1885 census taken is given.
